Cub Scout Fun Day Planning Guide

Location: Cub Scout Fun Day will be located on the Southeast side of the college.

Check-In: Registration begins at 8:30 a.m. Please send one adult to the registration tables with a complete roster of all the youth and adults that are with you. We will be able to accept final late fees for each unit at that time. Please have exact payment ready. Checks need to be made out to the Longhorn Council, BSA. This adult will also pick up the Pack's wristbands (required for activities, and safety), activities map, and patches. Registration is open so packs may check-in at their leisure throughout the day.

Parking: There will be a parking lot available near the activity stations for participants and volunteers to park. The location of this parking lot is on the southwest side of the college. Please plan on carpooling with your pack.

Activities: Activities will open at 9 a.m. and run till Noon. Most of the staffed activity stations will close from noon to 1pm and reopen from 1-4pm. Unstaffed activity stations will remain open during lunch. There is no set rotation for your pack - your pack will be able to move freely around the grounds and visit all the activities. Instructors on the BB and Archery range have a heavy responsibility for your child's safety. They can and will ask anyone that is not serious to leave the area. Please help them to keep the ranges safe.

Lunch: No meal service is provided. Participants and Volunteers must bring their own lunches.

Clean em' up and move em' out: The event closes at 4:00 pm.

What to bring to Cub Fun Day:

1. At least one water bottle per person
2. Comfortable tennis shoes
3. Please dress according to the weather. The event is entirely outside.
4. A sack lunch for each person attending
5. Bring a poncho, raincoat, or other rain gear with you. You may leave these items in your car. The show will go on rain or shine.
6. A roster to be turned in at Registration for each youth and adult attending. This roster will be used by the camp director in case of emergency.

Rules to help you plan:

1. Remember that we strongly suggest one adult per youth. This applies to the Cub Scout Rules.
2. Please report all major accidents to the health officer.
3. Remember that we are here for the boys and that we must let them have fun.
4. No Riding in the Back of trucks. No Pets. No alcoholic beverages.
