## January 2012 Camp Improvements Update

Our new Longhorn Council Scout Executive, John Coyle, is committed to improving our camp facilities & programs. John has been attending District Roundtables, camps, & events throughout the Longhorn Council to hear the views of Scouters so that their suggestions & concerns may be addressed. **Upgrading & adding summer camp bathrooms & showers is now our top facilities priority. Our 2011-2012 winter projects include our campsite latrine upgrade project, new tents for all camps, professional boat overhauls, and more** (see the many projects below). Be sure to watch as we continue to push hard to improve our camps & facilities over the next few years.

## NEWS UPDATE for January-February 2012

The Longhorn Council's new Strategic Plan emphasizes major improvements to the facilities and programs at our camps, including new and rebuilt bathrooms & showers at our 3 big summer camps. Many projects have already started. Many more to come!

## Latrine Rebuild started at Worth Ranch & SR2



Our Rangers and a crew of construction workers are in the middle of the project to rebuild campsite facilities at Worth Ranch and SR2. The new ones have individual stalls and modern toilet risers, and a pair of in-campsite shower stalls.

## New Showers & Bathrooms

**2 New adult leader showers and bathrooms** open in May at Sid Richardson Scout Ranch and Chisholm Trail Adventure. We are currently replacing the youth shower at the Worth Ranch Bottoms campsites with a new shower with individual stalls. In May we will add individual stalls to the 2 youth showers at the SR2 campsites.

## New TENTS and Frames *January 2012 Update*

We are building permanent pole frames for the new tents. We purchased 75 new tents for this summer at Camp Tahuaya, 100 for Worth Ranch, and over 100 for SR2. The new tents are slightly wider to give campers more living space. We will also be adding new Staff tents.



## New Backhoe at Camps

We purchased a big new backhoe and trailer in December for our summer camp building projects & repairs. *January 2012 Update*



## 2012 Sailboat Upgrades



We are spending \$20,000 this winter to upgrade the sailboat fleet. The summer camp Sailing Base will have 30 sailboats in 2012! The hulls are being re-glassed and the rigging and sails professionally re-outfitted.



## 2012 Wakeboard Boat Upgrades

We are replacing 1 boat. Our Mastercraft has a new engine. All boats are going back to the dealers for a complete servicing & refitting.



## Pontoon Boat Upgrades

We are replacing the furniture on 8 more of our High Adventure Base's 23 pontoon boats. We re-outfitted 8 boats in 2010. We have also replaced the older engines.

## New Automatic Skeet Throwers

In 2011 we added new Atlas Auto Throwers, with batteries and chargers for the Shotgun Merit Badge programs at Worth Ranch and Camp Tahuaya. The Sporting Clays range at SR2 has 6 trailer-mounted Matarelli auto-throwers.



## New Truck for Camp Tahuaya

We purchased a new 4x4 long-bed pickup truck for Camp Tahuaya in *January*.

## Rifle & Shotgun Instructors



We are adding additional Rifle & Shotgun instructors at Worth Ranch & Tahuaya in order to offer more Rifle & Shotgun Merit Badge classes for Troop attending summer camp.

## WR Scoutmaster Shoot

The Longhorn Council Shooting Sports Chairman will run a Scoutmaster Shotgun tournament on Monday night during each week of summer camp at Worth Ranch. All adult leaders in camp are invited.





## Scoutmaster Steak Dinners in 2012

We are adding a Steak Dinner for all adult Scouters each week of summer camp at Camp Tahuaya, SR2, and Worth Ranch.

## New Merit Badge Classes

Our Program Directors are adding many more merit badges for our 2012 summer camp program. This summer we will offer:

- 54 Merit Badges at Camp Tahuaya
- 56 Merit Badges at Worth Ranch
- 74 Merit Badges at Sid Richardson Scout Ranch.



## Robotics Merit Badge

Scouts may try the new Robotics Merit Badge at **SR2 & Tahuaya** in 2012. The BSA-recommended robot kits are \$159.99 plus some extras. Must be ordered in advance. Scouts keep their robot, kit, & carry box.
