

Cub Scout Trout-O-Rees 2012

6 Trout - Patches - Prizes - Lunch - Awards - Camping - Cub Scout Fishing Skills Workshop

Now two Trout events each weekend: fish on Saturday OR fish on Sunday morning. Each December the lake at Camp Tahuaya is stocked with over 2,000 Rainbow Trout from Missouri. Cub Scouts and parents catch and keep up to 6 Trout per person (12 Trout per parent/youth team). Cub Scouts enjoy a day of fishing with a parent, Trout-O-Ree patch, Prizes, lunch, fishing education programs

NOTE: PLEASE make sure your group knows to bring #10 OR SMALLER HOOKS! Best rigs are light 6' or longer fishing rods rated for 4 lb to 10 lb line (2kg to 5kg) and loaded with 4 lb-5 lb test line. (Shorter rods are harder to learn to cast with.)

Fee: \$27.00 per person; includes catching up to 6 trout per person, patch, lunch, prizes, awards, and liability insurance.
NO WALK-INS. Fishing Licenses NOT needed.

Cub Scout Fishing Work Shop – Sat. only. NEW!

To earn requirements for the Cub Scout Fishing Belt Loop / Pin. Classes will be in hour sessions starting at 9am till 3pm. Sign up sheet will be available during the day for a time schedule. Certificates of requirements completed are handed out at end of day at the campfire to take back to your Den leaders for approval. Belt Loops and Pins are not furnished. The Fishing Belt Loop & Pin is for Cub Scouts and Webelos. Webelos who are working the Sportsman Activity Pen can earn part of requirement #3.

Fishing Work Shop will include regulations & rules, outdoor code, bait a hook, catching a fish, cleaning a fish, fish habitats, types of fishing reels, tying fishing fly lures, casting 30ft, draw a fish, replace line on a reel, make a pole and line rig, artificial bait & lures. Also there will be many fishing stories told.

Trout-O-Ree PRIZES:

AWARDS:

- **Largest Fish of Other Species:** bluegill, catfish, largemouth bass.
- **Funniest Catch** - from the lake: shoes, watches, glasses, etc
- **Prize for the Largest bag of trash** - from the lake & woods

WHAT TO BRING:

- 6' or longer light Fishing rods and reels rated for 4-10 LB line and loaded with 4 lb-5 lb test line
- Tackle: # 10 or smaller hooks, small lead sinkers, bobbers, etc.)
- Bait: Powerbait (various colors), corn, pieces of hot dog, etc.
- Scissors or pocket knife, needle nose pliers, cleaning knife
- Fish Stringer, Cooler & ice

RULES

- Each participant must stop fishing when they have caught their limit of 6 trout. Adults / Parents must let Cub Scouts catch their own trout and other fish.
- Cub Scouts may compete as individuals only where a family has more boys than adults. Each team is a pairing of 1 youth & 1 adult.
- Teams and individual participants must weigh their fish once they finish or catch their trout limit.
- Cub Scouts & adults keep the fish they catch (bass, trout, bluegill, catfish), but must stop fishing when they catch 6 trout.
- Only trout and bass count toward the prizes.
- Only bank fishing is allowed. No boats or wading.
- Limit: 90 fishermen. Registration is 1st Come-1st Serve. Registrants over 90 will be placed on a waiting list or moved to the next trout day.
- Fishing at Camp Tahuaya is off limits except at Cub Scout Trout-O-Rees, Boy Scout-Venturing Trout Tournaments, Cub Scout Resident Camp, & Boy Scout Summer Camp.

Catch and Release of Trout is NOT allowed for any reason and will result in immediate disqualification.
