Boy Scouts & Venturing

6 Trout - Patches - Prizes - Lunch - Awards - Camping - Fishing Tips

Now two Trout events each weekend: fish on Saturday OR fish on Sunday morning. Each December the lake at Camp Tahuaya is stocked with over 2,000 Rainbow Trout from Missouri. Participants keep up to 6 Trout per person. No limit on Bluegill. Enjoy a day of fishing, Trout patch, Prizes, lunch, and fishing education tips. **NOTE:** Please make sure your group knows to bring #10 OR smaller hooks. Recommended casting rigs are light 6' or longer fishing rods rated for 4 lb to 10 lb line (2kg to 5kg) and loaded with 4 lb-5 lb test line. Shorter rods are harder to learn to cast with.

Fee: \$27.00 per person; includes catching up to 6 trout per person, patch, lunch, prizes, awards, and liability insurance.
NO WALK-INS. Fishing Licenses NOT needed. Limit: 80 fishermen.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Fishing rod and reel
- Tackle (hooks, small sinkers, lures, etc.)
- Bait (Powerbait works well)
- Fish Stringer
- Scissors or pocket knife, needle nose pliers, cleaning knife
- Cooler & ice

11:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Grilled Lunch
3:00 PM Awards

RULES

- Each participant must stop fishing when they have caught their limit of 6 trout. Adults / Parents must let Scouts catch their own trout and other fish.
- Scouts may compete as individuals or in parent / youth teams. Each team is a pairing of 1 youth & 1 adult.
- Teams and individual participants must weigh their fish once they finish or catch their trout limit.
- Scouts & adults keep the fish they catch (bluegill, catfish, bass, trout). Each person must stop fishing when they have caught 6 trout.
- Only trout and bass count toward the prizes.
- Only bank fishing is allowed. No boats or wading.
- Limit: 90 fishermen. Registration is 1st Come-1st Serve. Registrants over 90 will be placed on a waiting list or moved to the next trout day.
- Fishing at Camp Tahuaya is off limits except at Boy Scout Summer Camp, Boy Scout-Venturing Trout Tournaments, Cub Scout Trout-O-Rees, and Cub Scout Resident Camp.

Catch and Release of Trout is NOT allowed for any reason and will result in immediate disqualification.

NOTE: Everyone attending must be registered in the Trout Tournament.
