F-16 Flight Simulator Cockpits

SR2 Aviation Merit Badge Program offers 16 F-16 flight simulator systems. All simulators are networked to allow Scouts to fly missions together or as opposing teams. The simulator cockpits use large screens and the same HOTAS throttle & stick used in military simulators.



FAST DRAW Competition Program

Camp Tahuaya SCUBA Program

Camp Tahuaya will offer SCUBA classes for up to 10 Scouts and adults at Camp Tahuaya in 2010. Classes will be taught by an experienced former Coast Guard Rescue Swimmer and Navy diver. Participants will take their classroom work online before camp through Scuba Schools International.



Camp Tahuaya G-Scale Trains for Railroading Merit Badge

New G-Scale outdoor model train facility for Camp Tahuaya's Railroading Merit Badge. Work with the camp's experienced instructor to operate and build track, bridges, and model railroad facilities for a large Garden Scale outdoor model railroad near the camp dining hall. Each Scout can build one G-Scale railcar or structure to keep & take home.



AREA 51 Program

Earn Aviation MB in our 16 new F-16 flight simulator cockpits and fly team-based air combat missions at our new flight center. July 4-10.



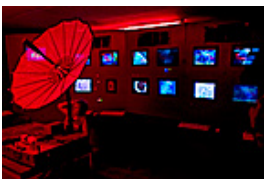
Shooting Sports Camp Week
