



## Requirements

1. Contribute to the World Friendship Fund (National) or World Scouting Contributions (Council) through your den/pack and learn how this money is used to help Scouts in other parts of the world. (There is no minimum contribution).
2. Complete the requirements for the World Conservation Award for Webelos (even if you earned the award as a Bear or Wolf).
3. Learn about the World Organization of Scouting Movement (WOSM). Make a display to share what you learned with others.
4. Host an individual or group of foreign students or Scouts at a dinner, a meeting or a campout weekend where activities are planned so that you learn about their country/countries.
5. Plan and execute an international dinner, participate in an international event or participate in a pack activity involving games from different countries.
6. Have a Scout or Scouter who has attended an international event or visited an international Scout center visit your den. Ask him/her questions about their experience.
7. Participate in a Jamboree-on-the-Air.
8. Find out about the Baden Powell House and the Kandersteg International Centre, Gilwell, or Brownsea Island. Make a display to share what you learned with others.
9. Participate in a pen pal program with a Scout in another country. Share your experience with your den and Pack.
10. Visit a Foreign Embassy or Consulate and find out about their Scouting program if possible or about their country in general. Share your experience with your unit.
