What are the Longhorn Council's Events?

The Longhorn Council's program events are a menu of programs designed to help units make Scouting more fun for their youth. The events offer activities that are unique or difficult for individual units to put on, and are open to all districts & councils. The goal is to offer units a menu of programs they can choose from as needed to supplement their unit program and help keep Scouting FUN.

Most of the Longhorn Council's programs are Cub Scout events. The 25 Cub Scout events are family oriented programs designed to encourage Cub Scout families, dens, and Packs to spend more time in the outdoors and to help Packs make Cub Scouting more fun for entire families. The goal is to help keep Cub Scouting fun so that more Cubs will continue on into Boy Scouts.

There are 5 Boy Scout and Venturing events throughout the program year, plus Trout Tournaments. The programs offered are designed to give units fun choices to supplement their unit program as needed.

Mountain Bike Trail Crews * Major Points

Troops and Crews may also perform service by doing 8 hours of trail building, working on the 30 mile SR2 mountain bike and hiking trail project. An experienced Trail Boss will provide tools and teach and lead trail building, erosion prevention and conservation techniques.

Leaders may also sign up for the International Mountain Bike Association Trail Building Conference held annually at Lakeview Lodge on the 3rd weekend in February. Contact the registrar for more information
