Fall Festival and Haunted Hayride Planning Guide

The most important part of any camp out is proper planning. Please take a few minutes to read the following paragraphs. Directions to camps and campsite maps are available at: www.longhorncouncil.org

Check-In: Begins at 12 noon. Please send **one** adult with a Roster of all attending youth and adults to check-in, complete unfinished registrations, and pick up event info, patches, and event Wrist bands for each participant. **SR2:** Check-in is held at the Buchanan Springs Activity Building (follow the signs). **Camp Tahuaya:** Check-in is conducted in the Camp Office.

Vehicle Safety: The speed limit on the main SR2 road is 25 mph. Speed limit in the campsite, program, & hayride areas at SR2 is 10 MPH. **Camp Tahuaya** speed limit is 10 MPH. Please obey posted speed limits. **NO ONE is allowed to ride in the back of a pick-up truck,** and everyone in the vehicle must utilize seatbelts, one belt per person. Please park and walk. Watch out for livestock, Scouts, and other cars.

Campsites: Please set up tents in your Pack's assigned campsite. Set up your group's tents together within the campsite; this permits your late arriving members to easily find you and leaves space in the campsite for other families to set up or for another Den or Pack if your campsite is shared. To limit the number of vehicles driving into the campsite area, please put as much equipment as possible into as few vehicles as possible to make your equipment drop-offs. **All vehicles must be moved to the designated parking area as soon as possible after dropping off gear.** Please bring trash bags with you. Pack your trash out: you are responsible to remove all of your trash when you leave. **Note:** Our latrines and showers are not stocked with toilet paper, bath towels, paper towels or soap; be sure to bring these items!

Parking: Fall Festival parking at **SR2** is in the designated "Camporee Grounds" Parking area located near the Camporee Grounds. **Camp Tahuaya** parking is in the camp parking lots. Overflow parking is along the main road.

1. If you ARE camping: Unload vehicles at your campsite and return them to the parking area. At **SR2** one vehicle per Pack may remain in or near the campsite in the Buchanan Springs area. Part of the fun is camping in the woods, not in a congested parking lot.

Rules To Help You Plan:

1. If a Scout/youth and an adult are sharing one tent, the adult must be a parent or guardian of the boy.
2. A wristband is required for all activities including the hayride and meals. Wrist bands must be immediately placed on either the right or left wrist of both youth and adults, and must be readily visible.
3. Instructors on the BB and Archery range have a large responsibility for your child's safety. Range Officers can and will ask anyone not taking safety seriously to leave the area. Please help us keep the shooting ranges safe!
4. Please report any 'substantial' injuries to the Event Director.
5. The show will go on rain or shine. Please Be Prepared--bring a poncho, raincoat, or other rain gear with you.
6. Remember: we are here for the boys, let's ensure they have FUN!!

8. No pets. No alcoholic beverages. No fireworks. No firearms.

2. **If you are NOT camping:** Park and unload vehicles in the designated parking area. NO parking on roads without Ranger permission.

Activities: 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.. Choose activities of interest and feel free to wander between events. Find events with no lines, there is no set rotation.

Lunch: Lunch is on your own.

Supper: 5:00 p.m. to 6:45 p.m.. Meal times are assigned; please honor your designated meal time.

Flashlights: For safety reasons, flashlights shall remain off during the hayride; adult leaders are responsible to enforce this requirement. Event volunteers have been blinded by flashlights and suffered injuries from falls, etc. Anyone who shines a flashlight on one of the haunted hayride volunteers will be removed from the hayride; the walk back can be long! Please help us keep everyone safe!

Hayride: Hayrides are approximately 20 minutes in duration. Each group will be assigned a departure time. Please honor your assigned departure time. We can accommodate 50 to 100 riders at each assigned departure time. To help accommodate as many guests as possible, please board and exit trailers as quickly and as safely possible from the rear of the trailer. Be sure to follow instructions from tractor drivers.

Sunday Breakfast: 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. continental breakfast.

Chapel: 9:00 a.m. Non denominational. Remember, a Scout is reverent and respectful of others religious beliefs.

Clean em' up and move em' out: Camp closes at 11:30 a.m. and it's time to head home! **Remember:** Everyone is responsible to police their campsite before leaving; a Scout is clean and always leaves a campsite cleaner than it was found.

Trash: Pack your trash out. Please bring trash bags with you. Do not leave trash at the camp.
