Jim Morton began Scouting at the age of 13 in Houston. Even though Jim thought he was too old and way too cool to be a Boy Scout his mother insisted. She was right, as Jim loved Scouting. After earning his Eagle Scout Award and finishing high school, Jim attended Baylor University where he met Pat. After graduation, Jim and Pat got married and moved to Dallas where Pat taught high school and Jim attended Baylor Dental School. While there, Jim was president of his dental fraternity. Upon graduation, he served 4 years in the Army Dental Corps with the first 3 stationed in Heidelberg Germany. Their daughter Ashley was born in the same hospital where the dental clinic was located. This is the same hospital and where General Patton died.

In 1976 at the age of 29 they moved to Waco, started a dental practice, had their son Chad, joined First Baptist Waco, and Jim became an Assistant Scoutmaster. He served in that capacity for 9 years. Fast forward to 1988 and Jim chartered Troop 497. He served as Scoutmaster for the first 5 years and was named District Scoutmaster of the Year two of those years. His son Chad earned his Eagle Scout Award in Troop 497. Once Chad and his contemporaries had aged out of Scouts several other Scoutmasters from Troop 497 (Dr. Dan Davis, Dr. Wayne Parks, Jerry Campbell, Jim Brooks, and Dr. Scott Littrell) formed a group of ex-scouters that would continue backpacking, hiking, canoeing, and biking together twice a year. Jim is a Fellow of the Academy of General Dentistry and has served as President of the Central Texas Dental Society, Chair of the Deacons at First Baptist Waco, and is currently on the Board of Directors of Alliance Bank of Central Texas.

Since retirement Pat and Jim spend their summers at their cabin in Glen Haven, Colorado along with their dog who is appropriately named Scout.
