





WISE COUNTY GOOD SCOUT OF THE YEAR LUNCHEON

Poy J. Eaton is the president and publisher of the Wise County Messenger, a weekly newspaper in Decatur, Texas, established in 1880, and owned by Roy and Jeannine Eaton since 1973. Under their stewardship, the Messenger, has won more than 300 awards for excellence in news coverage and advertising, including the National Newspaper Association's coveted "General Excellence" award for twice-weekly newspapers in 2005, 2010 and 2012.

Mr. Eaton has received numerous recognitions throughout his illustrious career including being inducted into the first class of the Texas Newspaper Hall of fame in 2007; into the Texas Radio Hall of Fame in 2008; elected to the Fort Worth Stock Show board of directors in 2009; named the first "Distinguished Alumnus" of Northwest High School in 2010; and in 2020 was presented the "White Helmet Award" from the Decatur Fire Department.

Roy has served his community in many ways. He served as president of the Decatur Economic Development Corporation, the Decatur Chamber of Commerce, chairman-of-the-board of the Wise Health System, chairman of the Decatur Home Rule Charter Commission and chairman of the Decatur Airport Advisory Committee. He is past president of the Northwest ISD Education Foundation board of directors and is president of the Wise County Water Supply District board of directors. He was named Decatur's "Citizen of the Year" in 1980 for his work in developing a county wide emergency medical service system and was instrumental in the building of the \$5-million Decatur Conference Center. In 2015 the Library and Research Center at Weatherford College/ Wise County was named in honor of Roy and Jeannine Eaton.

Roy and his wife Jeannine are both graduates of Northwest High School and Texas Christian University. They are the parents of three sons and have six grandchildren. They are members of the First United Methodist Church of Fort Worth and the First United Methodist Church of Decatur.
