# Basic Canoe Race Information

**\*NOTE: The camp road down the hill to the Bottoms Campsites is RESERVED for camp vehicles and boat trailer shuttle vehicles only during the race from 10:00 a.m. to 2:30 PM! Please keep vehicle travel to a minimum! Thank you for your cooperation!**

1. Take your Check-In packet to a nearby table and fill out the **Canoe Race Team Roster** Form. You should have one form for every twelve boats your unit plans on fielding. Please ask a member of the Check-in staff if you need more forms or assistance in filling them out.
2. Get **wristbands, lunches, and T-shirts**. Be sure to let the Check-In staff know if you have volunteers who can help with driver shuttle, trailer shuttle, or race timing.
3. All participants **MUST** wear their wristbands to check out a boat for the race and to eat supper.
4. Turn in completed **Canoe Race Team Rosters** for every boat in your unit **TO THE CHECK-IN STAFF**. They will then issue your **Race Numbers**.
5. Set **shuttle** as necessary (drop a vehicle at the 6-mile takeout point – see maps). Please do not leave more than one vehicle per unit at the bridge for the 6-mile take-out. Use that vehicle to bring drivers back to camp to get the rest of your vehicles.
6. Report to the Race Start points at least half an hour before your start time to check out boats and gear and get in line and ready to race.
7. Scouts may only paddle a kayak if they are pre-registered to kayak. Please leave the kayaks for those that pre-registered to use them
8. Be **IN POSITION** at race start time. Make sure that you report at the correct race time, based on your wristband color. Adults should always serve as safety patrol on the river.  
8:00am.....**14-Mile Race – at the Hwy 16 bridge**  
9:30-10:00 am.....Begin getting boats at put-in. **Please empty one trailer at a time.**  
10:00am.....6-Mile **Heat #1 bands**  
10:30am.....6-Mile **Heat #2**  
11:00am.....6-Mile **Heat #3**  
11:30am.....6-Mile **Heat #4**  
12:00PM.....6-Mile **Heat #5**  
12:15PM.....6-Mile **Heat #6 (and WALK-INS)**
9. **RACE FINISH LINE DIRECTIONS:**
  - a. **Race numbers MUST be worn on the FRONT of the PFDs.**
  - b. Paddle all the way to the Race Judge at the finish line. Tell the Race Judge your race number.
  - c. Load each canoe ASAP on a trailer *immediately after finishing* and tie it on the trailer.
  - d. Take Race numbers off of PFDs.
  - e. Stack paddles & PFDs where directed.
  - f. Send drivers back to camp to get all of your vehicles to pick up your boys.
10. **War Canoe Races** are held in the afternoon from 4:00 – 4:45pm. Heats are open to any team from any unit. Teams can race more than once if they like. Best time wins. Teams must help the crews of sunken boats recover their gear after each race.
11. Report to **supper** at assigned group time. Everyone must have a wristband to eat. 14-Mile Race are welcome to eat at either supper time.  
5:30..... **Supper Group 1**  
6:15..... **Supper Group 2**
13. Awards will be after Supper (approx. 7:00 - 7:15pm), at the dining hall – depending on how fast the race time data entry is finished. PLEASE help the cooks clean up the dining hall! Let's leave the camp and campsites cleaner than we found them!
