Covid-19 Safety Protocols

The Longhorn Council cares deeply about the health and safety of all Scouts and their families. All week-end events have been redesigned to incorporate the latest CDC and State guidelines and make them as safe as possible during the pandemic. The updated event plans make it possible for Scouts and families to have fun outdoors while safely following current social distancing & hygiene protocols.

- ⇒ Attendance has been limited.
- ⇒ Arrival, check-in, and program/start times will be spread out by appointment to avoid crowds.
- ⇒ BB & Archery times by appointment.
- ⇒ Events with frequently touched items are redesigned for cleaning and sanitizing between uses. Example: BB guns sanitized for each Scout
- ⇒ Camping is limited to one unit per campsite.
- ⇒ Masks are required.
- ⇒ Events are redesigned to be easier as Day Trips.
- ⇒ CUB-O and Score-O have been redesigned to have staggered start times by individual units throughout the morning and afternoon from 8 Start lines to turn one big start into hundreds of small team starts. The markers will have codes to write down, rather than hole punches to touch.
- ⇒ Restrooms & portajons to be regularly sanitized.
- ⇒ Bounce houses are retired until pandemic is over.
- ⇒ Haunted Hayrides are now a Haunted Trail.

What are the Longhorn Council's Events?

Longhorn Council's weekend events are a menu of programs designed to help units keep Scouting fun for their youth. The events offer activities that are unique or difficult for individual units to put on, and are open to units from all districts & councils. The goal is to offer units a menu of programs they can choose from as needed to supplement their unit program and help keep Scouting FUN.
