



Family Adventure Camp Keeping Youth Safe Policy

Family Adventure Camp (FAC) has adopted the following policies for the safety and well-being of all attendees. These policies primarily protect youth attendees; however, they also serve to protect adult attendees. When we provide an encouraging environment for youth, positive experiences can flourish.

Reservations

- FAC is open to all families camping and attending for the day. We request that there be at least one youth per party (Friday – Sunday).
- All adult attendees will have a background check conducted by FAC prior to arrival per the State of Texas.
 - FAC has the right to refuse entrance to any adult who does not fulfill the background check/approval process.
- Only attendees listed on the reservation are permitted at FAC. If you need to add an additional attendee, the Concierge Team can assist upon arrival.

Adult Supervision

- One-on-one contact between adult and youth attendees is prohibited (parent/guardian and youth relationship excluded). Two adults must be present at all activities and experiences (one adult could be a staff member).

Responsibility

- All persons at FAC share the responsibility for safety. Additionally, adult attendees are required to acknowledge and adhere to the FAC Code of Conduct.
- All persons are responsible for treating each other with respect and dignity.

Media

- No form of media, digital or otherwise, including but not limited to, cell phones, cameras, recording equipment, shall be used in restrooms/showers, changing areas.
- Please only use media devices where it relates to your immediate party unless the proper authorization is received for members outside of your reservation.

Accommodations

- Separate sleeping accommodations must be made for all those outside of your family.
 - Family members from the same household may utilize the same accommodations.
 - Current programs in the BSA may have additional requirements.
- Only utilize your assigned accommodations unless you receive approval to enter a different site.

Program Requirements

- Adults and staff should emphasize travel in groups of 2 or more. Families are encouraged to participate in experiences together. Some activities do require adult participation with youth.

Discipline

- Discipline should be constructive
- Behavior not conducive to a Family friendly Adventure environment will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis which could include, but is not limited to: corrective action, removal from property, limited or permanent ban of future participation.

Reporting Requirements

- All persons have a responsibility to recognize, respond to and report all “Keeping Youth Safe” violations and abuse to the Welcome Center (Add Phone Number)
 - If you see something, say something.
