

# FAMILY ADVENTURE CAMP AT TAHUAYA

## CAMP RULES

- Reservations: Must be 21 or older to make a reservation.
- Tobacco and Vaping: For the enjoyment of all our guest, smoking, chewing tobacco and vaping are NOT permitted.
- Alcohol: NO alcohol of any kind is permitted.
- Fireworks, Weapons, or Firearms: None of these are permitted on the property, including those with a permit. Hatchets, Axes, Bowsaw are permitted for cutting wood in a pre-approved axe yard. Pocket Knives with a blade of 3.5 inches or less are permitted.
- Quiet Hours: Enforced each night from 10:30pm to 6:30am. During this time, please keep voices and other noises to a minimum and turn off any amplified sound. Please ensure that noise, human or otherwise, cannot be heard beyond your site boundary. At all times, please be mindful for other guests and refrain from making excessive noises
- Parking: All vehicles must be parked in the main parking lot during your stay. You may request a permission to drive your vehicle to your site to drop off equipment.
  - Camp Speed Limit is 5mph unless otherwise posted
- Supervision: Parents are responsible for their child(ren)'s actions. Youth under 11 years of age are to be accompanied by an adult to all areas of the camp. All those under 11 years of age are to be at their site during quiet hours – 10:30pm to 6:30am
- Campfires: Campfires are part of the camping experience and are allowed in the designated site fire ring(s). Only burn wood found on the ground; you may also purchase a fire kit at the camp store. All fires must be properly extinguished when not attended/departed and must be of reasonable size so as not to endanger anyone or anything.
- Aquatics: Proper swim attire is required in the pool and waterfront area. Cut offs and street clothes are not acceptable.
- Wristbands: Each guest will be issued a wristband upon check-in which must be always worn to identify you as a registered guest. These wristbands also serve as your ticket to fun and will also indicate age-appropriate experiences and activities. You may be turned away from an experience or activity if your wristband not present. If you need a replacement wristband, please come to the Welcome Center.
- Dumping Tanks: Emptying grey water or sewage tanks on the grounds is in violation of Texas State Law and will not be tolerated.
- Pedal or Motorized Vehicles: Golf carts, skates, rollerblades, skateboards, scooters and/or dirt bikes are NOT allowed unless part of an official program. ADA-compliant golf carts and electric scooters are allowed for our special needs guests only. ATVs are only permitted as part of an approved program. Bicycles are allowed and require a helmet to operate (only during day light).

- Laundry: Clotheslines are permitted for the purpose of drying swim attire and towels. Clotheslines should be at least shoulder height, properly marked and not across walking paths. Clotheslines are NOT permitted in the RV park.
- Trash: Trash bags should be placed at the road of our site between 10am – 12pm for pick up. Please be sure to walk your entire site and pick up trash before departure.
- Pets: Pets are allowed but are limited to dogs ONLY and must remain in your designated RV space. However, service animals are always allowed (must have proper documentation). There should not be more than two dogs per site without approval of management. Any / all pets acting aggressively will not be allowed to remain on park premises & guests may be asked to leave with NO refund. Each guest is responsible for cleaning up after his pet and keeping the pet under control (leashed and refrained from excessive barking) throughout the entire resort. The leash is not permitted to extend beyond your site boundaries.
- Site Lock: Specific sites and facility may be requested but are not guaranteed. We do offer you the opportunity to guarantee your favorite campsite or cabin by paying our applicable site-locking fee. If you opt out of the site-locking fee, you are guaranteed your selected site area or facility, but NOT the specific unit number.
- Management reserves the right to evict, at our discretion and without refund, any person(s) whose conduct is objectionable or violates our Resort's rules, regulations and/or any staff directives.
- FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH RULES WILL RESULT IN THE TERMINATION OF THE SITE SERVICES AGREEMENT AND WILL REQUIRE YOU TO VACATE THE CAMP PROPERTY IMMEDIATELY WITH NO REFUND.
